All the light blue handmade papers were printed all over on the proofing press with ocher brown printing ink, on both sides. The color of the paper shimmers slightly through the brown. The reduced shapes of horses are printed on it in white. This makes the pictures landscapes.

A collaboration with Chinghiz Aitmatov and Jutta Schwöbel printed in letterpress,

24x36 film photos were transferred analogously to the printing plates

Typefaces (including size and weight): ctlCirillitza 14/16 for the text in Russian ctlCochin roman 18/29 for the German translation handwriting in Uigur alphabet by Prof. Dr. Weiers, digitalized, for the Kyrghiz translation

Brief description:

Thousands of years ago there was no alphabet yet, no books yet, there were the Akyn-riders — singing about the past and the news. Chinghiz Aitmatov the most famous Kyrghiz author (with his work tranlated in more than 100 languages) has written a poem for this edition about the friendship of horse and men. The book is a collaboration with the photographer Jutta Schwöbel. Printed in Russian, Kyrghiz and German language, with three alphabets.

Schwöbel's photgraphs of horses make landscapes of Kyrgyzstan.

The bound book is coming in a folder with two prints of 135x40cm each, printed with white ink on white Chinapaper. Wooden slipcase.
